

2023 ASNE-Sika Ultimate Build-A-Boat Challenge

The 27th Annual ASNE-Sika Ultimate Build-A-Boat Challenge took place June 10-11 at Harborfest®. We had 27 teams participating and many volunteers to help with all the logistics. A huge THANK YOU to our Sponsors and volunteers!

The net proceeds from the event go to support ASNE mission areas such as Engineering Scholarships, STEM grants and professional development programs. Our local Tidewater Section of ASNE funds <u>four</u> \$4,000 engineering scholarships and ten \$500 STEM grants annually in recent years. Yes, that's \$21,000 per year towards inspiring and supporting the next generation of engineering and technical professionals.

ASNE Scholarship Awards!

The results are in! In April the ASNE Scholarship Committee selected this year's ASNE Scholarship Awardees. **Ray Weber** and **James Deputy** were present in the ranking meeting representing the Tidewater Section.

This year the Committee had a very good list of highly qualified candidates. However, like our Tidewater Section, other Scholarship Accounts have been negatively impacted by the COVID shutdown of society wide fund raising activity. So, overall, they had only 11 scholarship sponsorships available to award this year.

There were 26 fully certified scholarship application candidates ranked, with 11 selected for scholarship awards and 2 alternates selected in case the committee chairman can find an additional scholarship sponsor within the society, or for award, if one of the original selectees fails to remain qualified, or drops out for some reason.

STEM AWARD TO LOCAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

With the funds received at ASNE Tidewater events like the annual Ultimate Build-A-Boat Challenge, ASNE Tidewater provides financial support to schools and clubs in the Tidewater area of Virginia for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) programs. On May 11th our ASNE TW Chair **Renée Reedy** and Vice-Chair **Joe Kosteczko** were excited to present a STEM award to **Jill Carlton**, the STEM program instructor at Ocean View Elementary School (OVES). OVES is a Title 1 School in Norfolk.

As Jill describes, "The gifted students at Ocean View are a very curious bunch. They love exploring and creating and have been working on basic coding and engineering briefs for the last few years."

She explained that the materials they'll purchase with the STEM award will give the students an opportunity to foster their critical thinking and problem solving skills. "It will be a wonderful educational experience for them to take that knowledge and apply it to robotics. We are hoping that experience and practice with these types of STEM materials will enable the students to participate in competitions and/or apply to specialty school programs. It will also inspire them to pursue careers in STEM." Jill and the school's Principal and Assistant Principal were very grateful for the grant.
