Rear Adm. Dennis Velez is a native of Adjuntas, Puerto Rico. He is a 1992 graduate of the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelor of Science in Aerospace Engineering. He also earned a master's degree in Information Technology Management from Touro University in 2004.

At sea, Velez completed tours aboard USS Stout (DDG 55), USS Carr (FFG 52), USS Gettysburg (CG 64), and USS Donald Cook (DDG 75). He served on afloat staffs with Commander, U.S. Second Fleet/Striking Fleet Atlantic aboard USS Mount Whitney (LCC 20) and as the deputy commander for Destroyer Squadron Fifteen in Japan. He was the commanding officer of USS Fitzgerald (DDG 62) and USS San Jacinto (CG 56).

Ashore, Velez served as officer in charge of Western Hemisphere Group Caribbean Area Coordinator; Surface Placement branch head, Head Junior Surface Warfare Distribution, Assistant Captain detailer and deputy director for Surface Warfare Distribution at Naval Personnel Command; Joint Staff Strategic Plans

and Policy Directorate as chief, North East Asia Division and assistant director for Political-Military Affairs, Asia. He was the senior military assistant to the 76th Secretary of the Navy.

His initial flag officer assignment was as commander, Navy Recruiting Command.

Velez was inducted in the Puerto Rico Military Hall of Fame in November 2021 and is the recipient of the Navy League's 2016 John Paul Jones Award for Inspirational Leadership. His personal military decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, and the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal. He is most proud of his appointment as an Honorary Chief Petty Officer.





STEM Award to Local Elementary School


With the funds received at ASNE Tidewater events like the annual Ultimate Build-A-Boat Challenge, ASNE Tidewater provides financial support to schools and clubs in the Tidewater area of Virginia for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) programs. On May 11th our ASNE TW Chair **Renée Reedy** and Vice-Chair **Joe Kosteczko** were excited to present a STEM award to **Jill Carlton**, the STEM program instructor at Ocean View Elementary School (OVES). OVES is a Title 1 School in Norfolk.

As Jill describes, "The gifted students at Ocean View are a very curious bunch. They love exploring and creating and have been working on basic coding and engineering briefs for the last few years."

She explained that the materials they'll purchase with the STEM award will give the students an opportunity to foster their critical thinking and problem solving skills. "It will be a wonderful educational experience for them to take that knowledge and apply it to robotics. We are hoping that experience and practice with these types of STEM materials will enable the students to participate in competitions and/or apply to specialty school programs. It will also inspire them to pursue careers in STEM." Jill and the school's Principal and Assistant Principal were very grateful for the grant.
